In Burundi, where the agriculture accounts around 35% of GDP (World Bank, 2011) and more than 90% of the labor force are engaged in the agriculture, improvement of the agricultural productivity is crucial. As the recent inflow of largenumber of returnees and the increase of population has aggravated the problem of land fragmentation, the challenge is of urgent need.
