E-JUST was established in 2010 in Borg El Arab, in the suburbs of Alexandria city which is the second largest in Egypt, under the bilateral agreement between the Government of Egypt and that of Japan. Postgraduate programs (Engineering) started in Feb. 2010, while Undergraduate Programs (Engineering, International Business and Humanities) was launched in Sep. 2017.

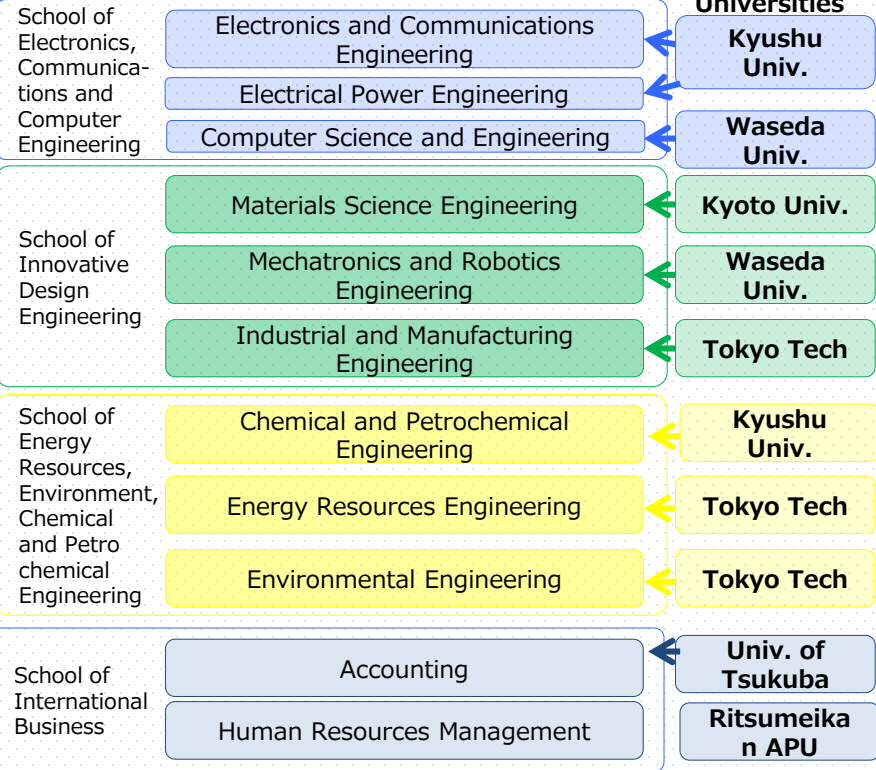

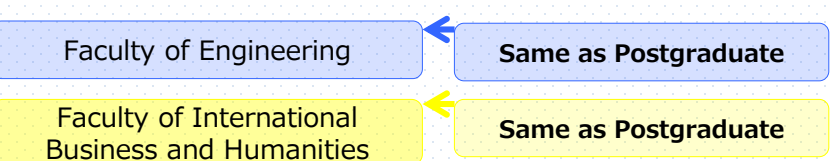
