





An Online Streaming Platform for Japanese Films and Other Video Content

A platform operated by the Japan Foundation that distributes Japanese films and videos worldwide for free with multilingual subtitles. Since its launch in August 2024, the number of registered users worldwide has reached approximately 100,000. The website supports 17 display languages, and the film subtitles are available in up to 19 languages. The lineup of streaming films is rotated periodically, and as of July 15, a total of 46 titles have been made available, including Under the Open Sky, The Great Passage, and JUNGLE EMPEROR LEO, aka KIMBA THE WHITE LION.

*Available countries/Regions and subtitle languages may vary depending on the film. Certain titles may not be available for streaming within Japan.
